


DWL BAT *

- ◆ Make a list or diagram of the differences and likenesses between owls and bats.
- ◆ As a class, talk about what is happening on each page. What emotions are expressed on the characters' faces?
- ◆ Discuss why the mothers seem wary of each other at the beginning of the story and what happened to change the way they felt by the end.
- Talk about why it is unfair to judge someone by the way they look.
- Break the class into groups to write text for the story.
 Then have each group share with the class.
