### Response

Should Emily be openly telling Ben about her problems online?

- ☐ **1** Yes, people online can offer comfort and Emily does not want to talk to her friends in school about this as it is embarrassing.
- ☐ **2** No, it is dangerous to share personal information to a stranger.
- ☐ **3** It is ok if Ben is a nice person.



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## Type of Resource:

This is a worksheet from PageWerkz that may be printed and distributed to students to educate them on how to act when chatting with someone they've met online. Kids will be asked to help Emily make decisions on how to respond to chat conversations with a person she has just met online (Ben). The actual courseware features animated, customized responses of Ben based on the responses chosen by the student for Emily. It also features tips at the end of the responses so that students will learn how to practice more caution when dealing with friends they have just met online.

## How to use this Resource:

You may use this resource if you are a teacher who aims to discuss online security measures to your students. Start the discussion by citing potential dangers that may be caused by interacting with unknown people online either through gaming apps or adding /talking to strangers on different types of social media platforms. You can then print the worksheet and let the students answer. Afterwards, you can ask students what other helpful safety & security advice they have for their classmates and ask them how they have dealt with difficult online situations in the past.



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## Correct answer for the Question in this Resource:

- For those who answer **1**, give **0 point**. Emily can call a helpline if she does not want to talk to schoolmates, teachers and parents. It is dangerous to talk to strangers online about personal issues.
- For those who answer **2**, give **2 points**. This is the best choice. We do not know the person's intentions so be careful not to share too much information.
- For those who answer **3**, give **1 points**. Ben may seem like a nice person online but Emily does not really know him. It is hard to tell if a person is genuinely nice from an online chat.
