## Type of Resource:

This is a printable first-grade worksheet that may be passed out to students to educate them on the **First Grade Common Core Standard on Mathematics** that teaches how to measure lengths indirectly by iterating length units. Based on the illustration shown, students will be asked to fill in the blanks with the correct words that compare the length of the objects/persons shown in the illustration.

The actual courseware is a workbook that provides students formulae sheets for checking/recalling math formulae, work exercises for becoming familiar with various questions and non-routine questions for developing analytical skills.

## How to use this Resource:

We highly recommend that you use this resource if you are a teacher who wants your students to learn about comparing the lengths of two objects by using a 3rd object and if you need a worksheet based on the **First Grade Common Core Standard on Mathematics** about measuring lengths through iterating length units. Start the discussion by getting three pencils of varying lengths and asking someone to volunteer to come up in front and answer questions about the length of the three pencils.

You can then print this worksheet and ask the students to answer the questions. After completing the worksheet, ask them to cite more examples of height or length comparison using their favourite objects or citing people they know as an example.
